He meant, as Paul wrote to the Philippians, that we should through the Holly Spain be "like-minded, having the same love, heing of one accord, of one mind" He said, "Let nothing be done strough strife or vainglory (vanity to exalt self of further one's personal interests); But in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves Look not every man on his own things . Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus (Philippians

You are not, then, allowed by God each to preach his own in-terpretations, but rather as Chein leads the IFAM!

In other words, God inspired Paul to admonish us Be strong unded, but Spirit-minded, and built led. Let God's Spirit make is all of ONE MIND — as a PEAM let your part in Gold's Work b your part in a LEAM ELFORT, all Mine be train tenderable

God wants us to be always mindful that to be a team, there must be TFAM LEADERSHIP!

Under what we call democracy, if I drive to an intersection with a stor sign. Lam not free to go on through if it is right in my own oyes. We are not free to do what-ever seems right in every individual's eyes. We still have LAWS, and codes and rules. And we have notice and other law enforcement agencies.
The DIFFERENCE is that in what

we erroneously call democracy, the PROPLE decide by vote on who shall be their leaders - whether mayor or governor or president. But THERE IS STILL RULE.

Christ is our Leader

The difference, then, is that in GOD'S GOVERNMENT, GOD decides, through Christ, WHOM He shall choose and install in office over His people in His Church. God's apostle cannot do as he pleases in his own personal in-

terest, but as CHRIST leads him. And if he doesn't? If he needs correction or removal? If so that is CHRIST'S responsibility - and responsibility of those UNDER the apostle to correct him

But maybe Christ is NOT LOOK ted or maybe Christ neglects to correct him? Should not the people under him then take it into their hands? To do so would be to DEFY CHRIST - TO TRY TO TAKE

Brethren, whether others know it or not I know well that Christ is not askeep at the switch - He will not neglect His job -- and I FERR to dishelieve that.

The BIG POINT WE must never lose sight of is that CHRIST IS THE and we'd hence all tremme at His Word¹

And that HITS THE MAIL SQUARKLY ON THE HEAD. The trouble, these past 10 years, is that too many have lost sight of the fact that curist is our INSPIRED LEADER. There has been too much tendency to look on the Church and the Work as OUR OWN SECULAR WORK — like any worldly club or business.

 even yet rescue this man from the consequences of rejecting truth.

I found him in the big au-ditorium, looking downcast and dejected, "Brother!" he exclaimed on seeing me. "Brother, something terrible has come over me. God has left me. He doesn't answer my prayers anymore. Be fore, God used me in a special ministry praying for the sick. He always heard and answered. People were miraculously healed. But not anymore! Not one, anymose, I don't understand it!"

'Truth -- or consequences'

Poor man! I understood. I tried to explain, but he wouldn't listen. He had been a trusting and deeply sincere, if simple and uneducated man. God had used him as an instrument in performing miracles, helping people.

I quoted to him from I John

3:22: "And whatsoever we ask we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight." But he could not see that rejecting God's truth and refusing to keep His command-ments had any connection with his case.

I had to think of the radio-television show originated by Ralph Edwards, Truth or Consequences. God had required him to accept the TRUTH or receive the consequences. I haven't seen or heard from that man since.




