Now back to our important question — although it was made clear in Part 3: How does Christ's broken body finake our healing possible? I answer withingnother question: How does Christ's ahed blood — His DEATH — make possible the forgiveness of spiritual sin — transgression of the spiritual law — the Ten Commandments? Simply by having PAID THE PENALTY IN OUR STEAD — THAT'S HOW! His beaten body paid in our stead the physical laws in the human body have been transgressed and have brought on the repark ty of the sickness, disease-or whatever—sometimes the first death!

To say there is my such thing as physical sin, as has been said by self-professing intellectuals, it is rank STUPIDITY. IGNORANCE OF WILLELL PREVENSION OF PLAIN, SHIPLE TREATMY.

Some lack the FAITH!

The important point here, however, is that some in the Church of God pt. Corinth did lack the faith to be healed—or else carelessly took the broken bread at Passover in an unworthy manner.

And WHAT WAS THE RESULT?
They were physically weak or
sick or had died that was the
PENALTY. They did not in faith
accept Christ's broken body as
paying of the penalty, which if
they had, would have heen by a
God given miracle removed
from them, and they should have
been stealap!

But sow it is infrontant that we note carefully that the assurt of this lack of sufficient faith tut not install them from the Church! Disfellowshipment is the penalty for causing divisions and offenbes (Romans 16:17-18). That is important!

If one in the Church of God today lacks the PALTH shar he should have the penalty is not distellowshipment. The penalty is that he still PAYS THE PENALTY in the form of sickness, disease or wen death the himself pays, it Too bad — when Christ already had paid it FOR MIM. But he whould be helped to receive tasth—not disfellowshipped.

Back in 1927 or 1928, when I had only recently at the time learned. God's truth about healing. I heard a most apt example of this

We did not yet cross the Atlantic in surplanes in those days A man was sailing to Europe in a trans-Atlantic steamship. He felt the meals aboard ship would be too expensive. So be packed in a suitcase a full surply of crackers and cheese. After three days sailing, he was becoming truly fed up on crackers and cheese. A steward had noticed that this pastemater never went into the ship's dinning room and asked him about

"Oh, I can't afford to eat in there," replied the pageinger Then he learned that MEALS WERE INCLUDED — no extra charge!

How many in God's Church, today are on averackers and cheese ration, when HEALING IS INCLUDED! IESUS CHRIST PAID FOR YOUR HEALING!

Why do YOU go on PAYING THE PENALTY or else paying the DOCTOR MILLS or probably BOTH, when Jesus Christ paid it all Jon you?

The weak in faith HELPED,

Now notice the important

teaching in Romans 14 a
"Him that is weak in the faith

Verse, 2 (Romans 14), although one believes (has faith) to cat meats, another, weak in faith, eaten only we getables. But the very fact he has not yet received FULL earth frond God does not bar him from God's Church. Rather this chapter in Romans teaches, receive them.—HELP the weak in faith. The ministers should teach him, more about the WAY, so make we more faith.

And so with the member of God's Church who has not as yet, schieved full parts to quatern coo's PROMISES for the physical healing. He should have that faith! He may pay hismelf the panelty of the stekness of disease if he lack? Sinth to believe Christ paid the principle of the panelty of the stekness or disease.

So therefore, if a member has

not yet grown in the FAITH-OF CRREST to absolutely know he can rely on God's smosters of healing — and if this member does call in the doctor or go to the used/scal profession for help; God's Church does not condemn him — but rather, God's ministers should encourage such a one to GROW IN FAITH until he can rely on God instead of telying on MAN.

Who is your neighbor?

We take it for granted that we know who our neigh hor is But there have been times when people didn't quite know, it seems some of us in the Church of God don't know either

Interestingly enough, the first part - love toward God -- is misunderstood by humans as a whole because man doesn't know God. How can you love someone you don't know? The Church of God should know who God is, so perhaps we can love God more than someone in the world. But it seems some in the world know who their neighbors are better than we

show you who your neighbor is I John flect says, "If you don't love your neighbor, you cannot love God for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love. God whom he han't seen? And this commandment we have from Him; that he who loves God should love his

Now of course you say, "Well-you retalking about a brother, ton a neighbor." But you see, there's our problem. Oftentimes we think only our brother is our neighbor. We don't realize that people in the world— We should have toward them the same attitude that we have toward our brothers

Some of us do things to belp someone only when asked to not spontaneously as a Christian should. Why Because we pretend sometimes (just as I'm going to show you now) not to know who the neighbor is




